Situational prompts provide specific information or instructions for a task or situation




Creative prompts encourage users to generate ideas or content

#### Designing Effective Prompts - Sequence of Progressive Chat Prompts





ChatGPT can be a transformative way for ENL teachers to combine language learning with content instruction. Here's a set of prompts across three proficiency levels that educators can use to scaffold their objectives:

1. Beginner Level:

Prompt for ChatGPT: "ChatGPT, help me design a basic lesson around animals. I want my students to name common animals and use simple sentences to describe them."

Content Objective: Students will identify and name at least five common animals.

Language Objective: Students will construct simple sentences such as "A cat is small" or "An elephant is big."

2. Intermediate Level:


